How to write a grant – advice from a successful applicant

by Assistant Professor Elske Salemink (University of Amsterdam)

In preparing a research grant, the opportunity to exchange experiences and ideas with others who have written successful grants can be invaluable. Elske Salemink is Assistant Professor at the University of Amsterdam (developmental psychology) and she was recently successful in obtaining a NWO grant (equivalent to the German DFG) and has offered to share her experiences of the grant preparation, writing, and application process with researchers at the LMU as part of the gender-mentoring programme. The talk is suitable for early-stage researchers who are aiming for an academic/scientific career. As well as including information on how to write a research proposal, the talk will cover more general issues of the skills and experiences which are important in becoming a successful grant applicant and academic researcher.
